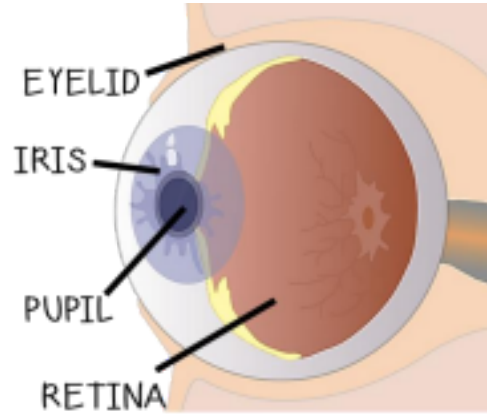

Central Nervous System

Brain

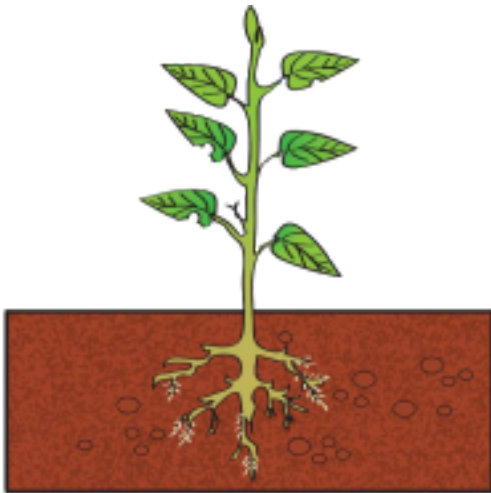
Your brain controls all functions in the body. This includes things like breathing, having a heartbeat, moving your arms and legs, etc. The brain controls these functions by sending and receiving messages through the nerves.

Spinal Cord

The spinal cord is the main pathway that connects the brain with the peripheral nervous system. It is protected by your spinal column, which is a long series of bones called vertebrae.

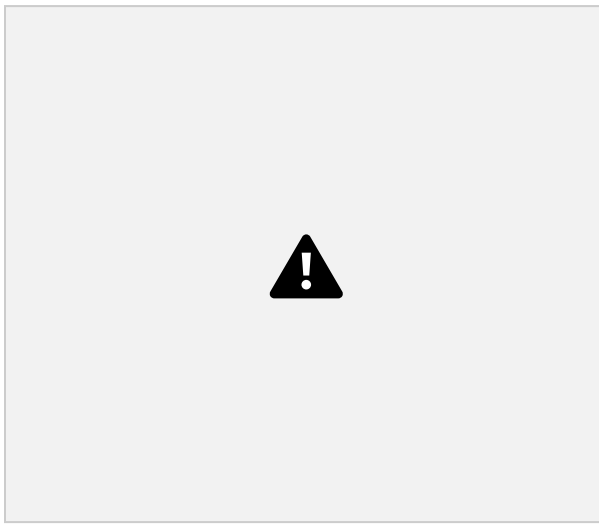
This is a side view of a human brain.



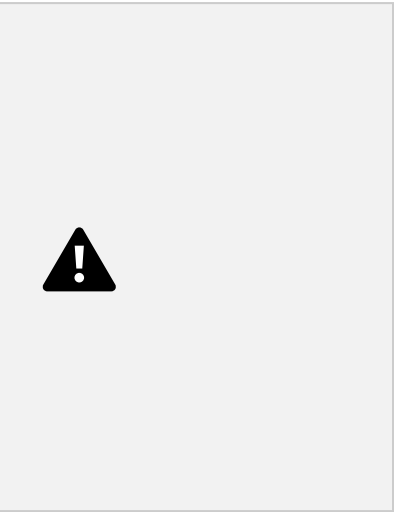
