Star of the Week Ideas

Due to our shortened Club Time, "Star of the Week" will be more of an "Introduction and Participation" piece. The Site Coordinator and Club Leader can discuss who will lead this part of the Program and what it will look like. Based on the size of your Site you can modify to include more or less of the Student/Tutor Pairs.

Here are some ideas:

Highlighted Helpers of the Week – Depending on the size of your site, introduce 1 - 3 Student/Tutor Pairs. Have them say their name (which when screens are set on Speaker View they will be seen by everyone). Have them answer a fun question that changes every week. The Student/Tutor pairs could be used as Highlighted Helpers to answer questions during the Lesson, keeping the number of participants trying to speak lower, but everyone knowing eventually they'll get that opportunity. The answer should be able to be just a couple of words. Some questions:

- a. If you could have any type of pet, nothing off limits, bird, insect, reptile, wild animal, domestic pet, absolutely anything, what would you pick?
- b. You get a double scoop ice cream cone, what 2 flavors do you pick?
- c. Favorites (color, animals, food, movie, book, person, etc.)
- d. What superpowers do you want to have?
- e. If you suddenly had the power to become invisible just for a day, what would you do?
- f. If you had a secret base, where would it be and what would be inside it?
- g. What is your superhero name?
- h. Where is the best place to hide during a game of hide-and-seek?
- i. If you opened a store, what would you sell?
- j. What is something your mom (or wife, or husband) always says to you?
- k. What is on your birthday wish list?
- I. What is your favorite chore?

Show and Tell – Notify Student/Tutor pairs in advance that they will be the Stars of the Week. Have them be prepared with an item. They share their names and show their item to the group; and can say just a couple of words about it. (Items could be stuffed animals, drawings, pictures, etc.)
